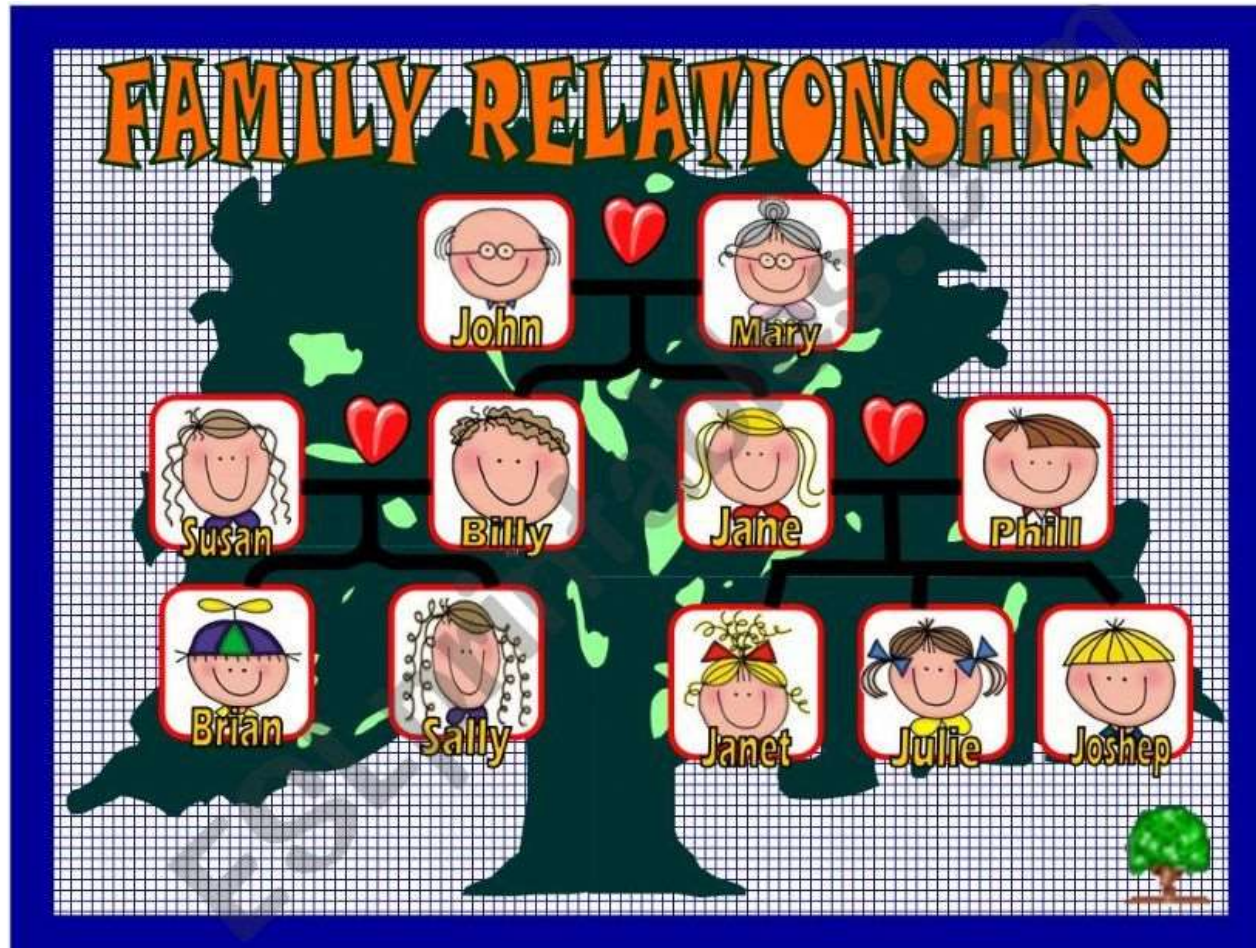


INSIDE IMPORTANT GLIMPS ABOUT FAMILY

Nuclear Family

- Nuclear family is also known as conjugal, elementary or traditional family.
- A family consisting of only a couple (ie. Mother and Father) and their children .
- Nuclear family does not consist of grandparent , aunts or uncles.



DEFINITION

- **NUCLEAR FAMILY---** A nuclear family consists of a married couple and their unmarried children.

JOINT FAMILY

- A joint family has parents and their married children living together.



Advantages of Nuclear Family

1. In a nuclear family, the parents and siblings provide all the support, companionship and advice to the children.

Nuclear Family

- Nuclear family make members of family more responsible.

- Small families have less financial needs.
- They have less quarrels and personal vendetta so less problems.
- Youngsters prefer freedom and less restriction choose nuclear family.
- Avoid stress in discomfort.
- Don't have to deal with problems.
- Nuclear families are usually a well maintained economical family.
- No need for time – share .

Disadvantages

Joint Family

- As a large family every one has to live in limited space .
- High earning members often insult the low earning members.
- For kids the study environment is hard to make as they spend most of time in playing.
- Jealousy is also very common in people when they are living under one roof.
- It's very difficult for a person to keep privacy in joint family system as all people are living together.

Nuclear Family

- The nuclear family is more likely to become isolated from their extended family members.
- The feeling of safety and security is lacking among the members of nuclear family.
- Family members particularly mothers , may have tendency to burn out from attempting to meet every person's need alone.
- Nuclear families can begin to develop like-minded thinking, which will lead to fewer arguments within the family unit.

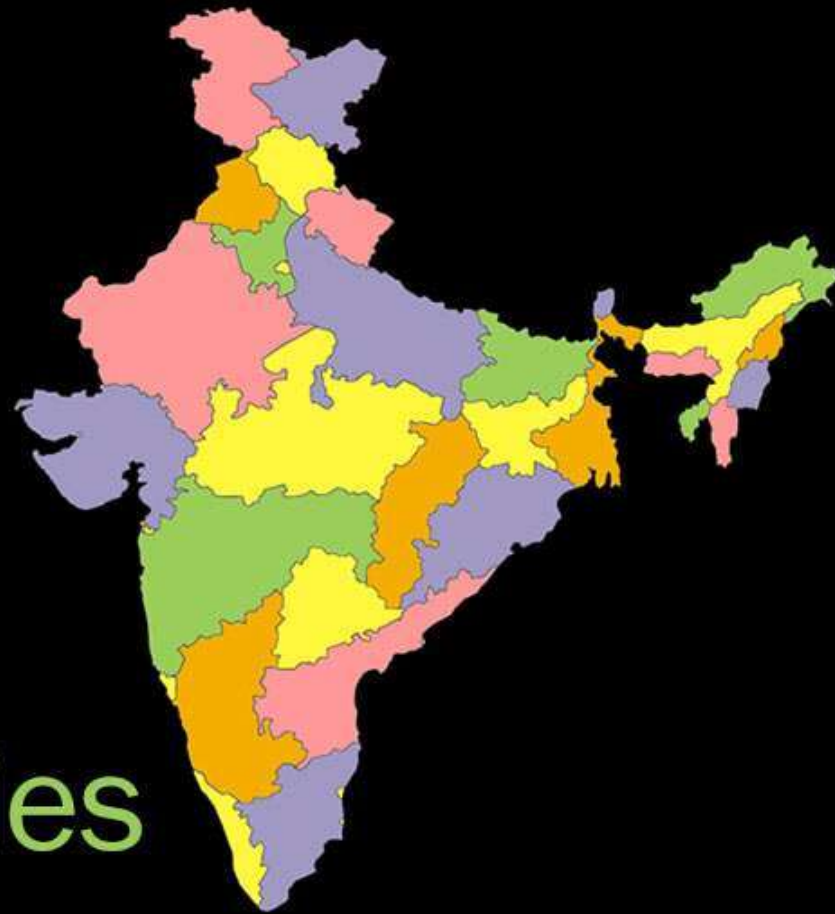
